The advent spiral of evergreens is a symbol of life, a picture of receiving and kindling our inner light to dispel the darkness around us. This is a reverent moment, and requires each individual to encourage calm and quiet after such a festive day. Please refrain from conversation and the use of cell phones, and quietly gather your children close to you as the community surrounds the spiral for this closure to our evening. As soon as the spiral is over, the 7th grade students will lead everyone to the exits in a gesture of goodnight.

Please leave silently, carrying the mood of the day along with you.

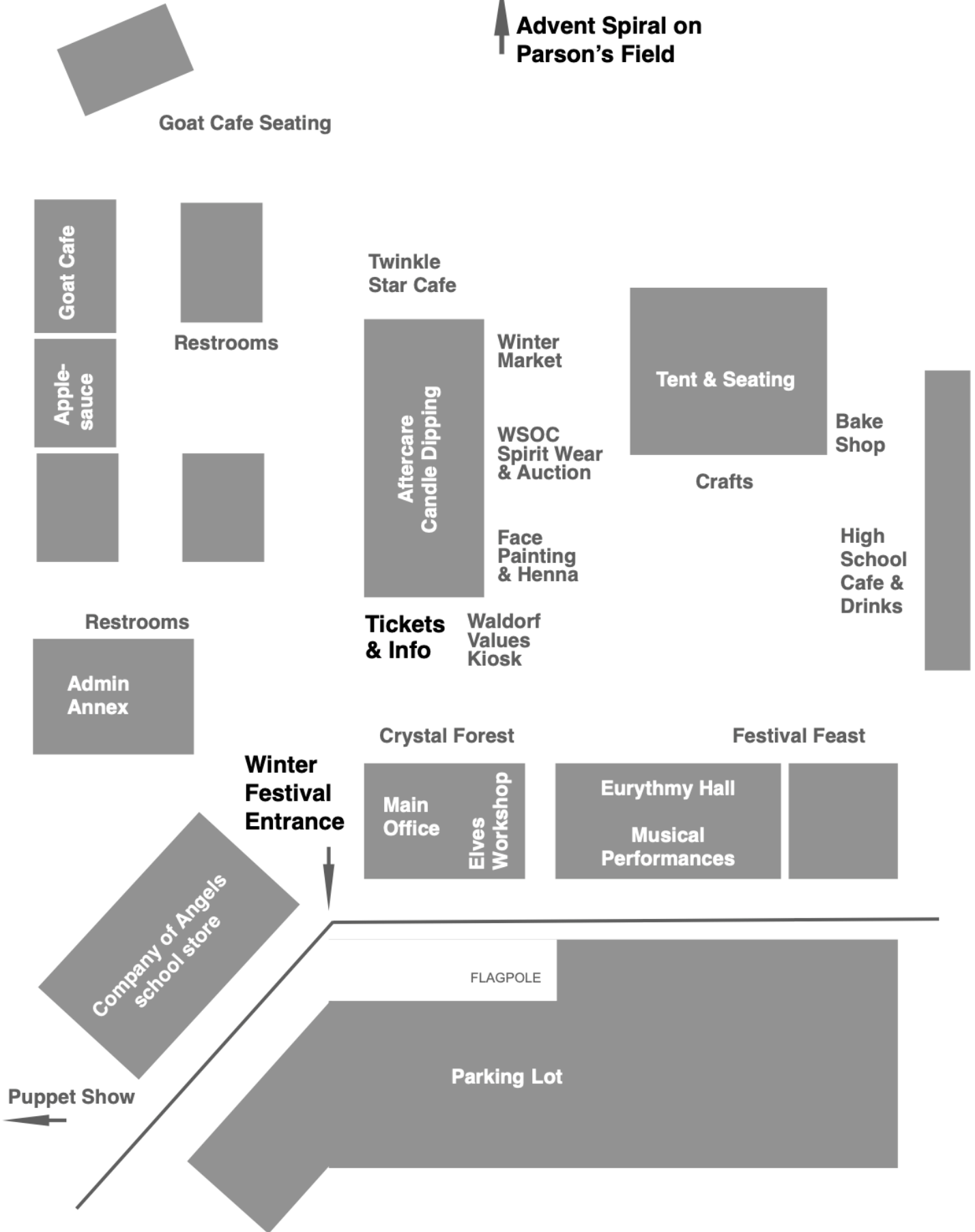

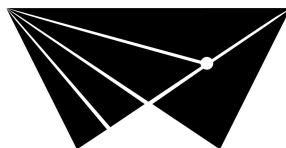
