Student Arrival

Students should arrive on campus between 8:00-8:10am each day. Class begins at 8:15am sharp. Students are expected to turn their phones in upon arrival or leave them at home. It is not safe to leave them in cars.

Technology Expectations

Students must bring a charged laptop to school with them each day. There are no minimum technical requirements. We also expect each student to have a working printer at home.

Calculators

Grade 9 and 10 students will need a scientific calculator such as the TI-30.

By grades 11 and 12, students will need a graphing calculator such as the TI-83, TI-84, or Casio fx-GC50. The TI-84 is a more commonly used graphing calculator with many excellent instructional videos, while the Casio fx-GC50 is a more economical option.
